JUDGE'S COMMENTS

It was a very long day 177 birds plus many miss-classified. Once the judging started I was very impressed with the quality and the condition of most of the birds on

the bench. Many of the birds were of good size and still retaining tight feather and excellent condition.

The Longefeathered Section was large with several top birds. The 1st and 2nd placed birds were very good examples of what a Longefeathered should be. Percentage birds did not place, as they are not true examples of what a Longfeathered should be. Fortunately we had almost all pure examples that were in good feather condition.

The quality of birds on the top bench is probably among the best I have seen at any National.
