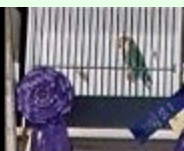

### Judge's Comments:

The end of another show season culminated in Tulsa, OK. The National had 92 Peachface Lovebirds shown by twelve exhibitors. I was very happy by the quality and variety of the birds shown. In fact I had to resort to counting flight feathers and checking toe nails to choose some of the section winners.

There were a lot of quality Orangeface birds and at one point during the show I had a fear that my entire top bench was going to be Orangeface birds. This did not come to pass, but the thought was there for a while.

My largest section was the Opaline section, I have noticed a trend here, every show I attended this year, the Opaline section has been the largest section.

In the end I put an almost perfectly symmetrical Green Pied in first place. The one difference I noted was that there were two black forward facing nails on one foot and only one on the other. The bird, of course, was in great condition and was the correct size and shape to be a champion Peachface. Congratulations to Jim Munis on a really very nice bird.

I also judged what appeared to be the first albino Peachface Lovebird to be exhibited in the U.S. It was a nice pure white bird with white eyes. When I first saw the bird, during my walk through, I thought it was there to stump the judge, but in fact, it looks as if we have an albino mutation at last. Is going to be very interesting to see what comes next from this new line.
