What a great experience was to be and judge the National Bird Show 2018 on its 70th anniversary. Once again, the Show took place at the Pheasant Run Resort in St. Charles, Illinois. Hotel commodities were excellent with plenty space for sponsors, vendors, exhibitors, birds and visitors. Get together with old and new friends on the hobby was just priceless. Judging process started at 8:15 am with a walk through where some birds were reclassified on its corresponding classes.

In Division 13 (Rares and Eyerings - Lovebirds) we had 118 good bird's belongings to 12 exhibitors. I want to express gratitude to my stewards Wendy Edwards and Dave Arthur, and my secretary Katy Secor who made my job enjoyable.

Section 1 (Rares): 11 birds. The winner of this section was an Abyssinian.

• Black-cheekeds and Abyssinians were shown.

Section 2 (Green Fischer's): 63 birds. The winner of this section was a Dilute Green (Light).

- 19 Greens-Type I. Most of them with almost perfect round orange bib and nice conformation.
 Missing flight and pin feathers was an issue that prevent some birds to advance. Other
 observations were that markings on the front and face side was not well defined in some cases,
 size and deportment can be improve. The bird that won this class took 5 in the top bench. This
 bird has almost perfect markings and color, just a little small for the standard.
- We had Type II, Darks Factors, Violets, Dilutes, Dark-Eye Clear, Lutino, Spangled, Pied, Misty, Euwing and Pale.

Section 3 (Blue Fischer's): 29 birds. The winner of this section was a Violet Blue.

• In this section we had Type I, Violets, Par-Blues, Dilutes, Spangled, Pied and Euwing.

Section 4 (Masked): 9 birds. The winner of this section was a normal Green Masked.

Only 9 birds in this section – Normal Green, Dark Factors, Violets, Dilute and Spangled.

Section 5 (Champions): 6 birds. The winner of this section was a Dilute Green Fischer's.

We had an Abyssinian, Type I Green Fischer's, Medium Green Fischer's and Dilute Green (Dark)
Fischer's.

After 5 and half hours of judging the top bench went as follow: Best in division was a stunning Violet Blue Fischer's with a brilliant feathers color, white clean face, nice head markings, perfect size and upstanding Deportment. 2nd best in division was a beautiful Abyssinian hen with a nice size, color and deportment. 3rd best in Division and best young was a Dilute Green Fischer's with a great orange head color, very good conformation and deportment. 4th best in show was a Violet Pied Blue Fischer's with a white head and nice pied markings. 5th was a Type I Green Fischer's with almost perfect markings and color. Places 6 to 20 were also beautiful birds that can win any show in the future.

I was so eager to see relative new mutations like Misty, Euwing and Pale in the show. Thanks to all the exhibitors for bring your birds to the show and let people look then closer.
